

#### **GLADYS BLACK 'WOMAN OF DISTINCTION' AWARD\***

#### JoAnne Reifsnyder, PhD, MSN, MBA, FAAN

Executive Vice President, Clinical Operations and Chief Nursing Officer at Genesis HealthCare



In her role at Genesis HealthCare, Dr. Reifsnyder is responsible for leader development, nursing strategy and clinical quality, safety and efficiency. She joined Genesis in 2011 as Vice President of Clinical Strategy and Implementation, and was previously Senior Vice President of Care Transitions at CareKinesis, Inc. Dr. Reifsnyder serves on the Board of

the Hospice Foundation of America and is the past President of the Board of Directors for the Hospice and Palliative Nurses Association. She is a member of the American Nurses Association, American Organization of Nurse Executives (AONE), the Hospice and Palliative Nurses Association (HPNA), the National Gerontological Nurses Association (NGNA) and Sigma Theta Tau International, the Honor Society of Nursing. Dr. Reifsnyder was inducted as a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing in 2015. She completed a postdoctoral fellowship in psychosocial oncology at the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing, and holds a PhD in nursing from the University of Maryland, an MBA from George Washington University, a master's degree in nursing from Thomas Jefferson University, and a BSN from Holy Family College.

Dr. Reifsnyder oversees the nursing department, social services and quality, and is responsible for the leadership development and career growth of more than 20,000 female clinicians.

As an advocate for its employees, MacElree Harvey recognizes the importance of gender balance in a team and the significant benefits it brings to the organization. For instance, the firm's Educational Assistance Program has been utilized by female staff and attorneys to further advance their careers. MacElree Harvey also offers work schedule flexibility, including the opportunity to work from home, to support work-life balance among its attorneys. Its Paid Medical Leave of Absence Plan provides paid time off for maternity leave, illness, or injuries. Finally, MacElree Harvey partners with the Chester County Bar Association to promote their Diversity Program, designed for first year law students who identify with groups historically discriminated against on the basis of gender, disability, race, or ethnicity.

#### IN MEMORY OF GLADYS BLACK




The Gladys Black 'Woman of Distinction' Award is named in memory of our late friend and committed Board member Gladys Black. Gladys led by example as a business leader in her field and an engaged and faithful supporter of her church, alma mater and a number of local organizations and non-profits.

A resident of Phoenixville, Gladys was a trustee of Allegheny College and in 2015 received the Alumni Medal, the college's oldest and most prestigious alumni award. In addition, Gladys was a major supporter of The Pennsylvania Ballet, People's Light and Theater, Philabundance, Episcopal Community Services and Orion Communities. She served as a membership volunteer at the Philadelphia Museum of Art and a supporter and devoted member of St. David's Episcopal Church.

In 1997, after the death of her husband, Joseph Black, she became Acting President of The Valley Forge Group comprised of Valley Forge Technical Communications in Exton and Detroit, Valley Forge Technical Information Services in Munich, Cologne and London, and Sun Technicom in Detroit.

As a business leader and supporter of women and girls in Chester County, Gladys left a lasting impact on our community. Her strength and extraordinary drive to give embodies the spirit of The Fund — we will never forget the impact she left on us and all those fortunate to have known her.






