- **Our GirlGov Chester County program is in the midst of its 4th year.** High school girls develop their leadership skills with hands-on experiences, learning how government works and being empowered to use their voices to advocate for issues important to them.
- **4th edition release of our 2022 Blueprint Report.** Thoroughly researched and updated every five years, this is a touchstone for nonprofits, government, and other community-based organizations to help focus their attention and resources to address the top issues challenging women in their efforts to become financially stable, healthy and safe. This edition includes the impact of the pandemic on Chester County women.
- **Our community collaboration and education forums**, both in-person and virtual, raise awareness and promote engagement to help women and girls rise.

Through the power of collective giving, The Fund's grantmaking in our last fiscal year touched over **16,500** community members in need. Over **13,500** identify as female.


18th Annual Making a Difference Luncheon | 05.05.23 | The Desmond Hotel in Malvern
