  years, this is a touchstone for nonprofits, government, and other community-based organizations to

  become financially stable, healthy and safe. This edition includes the impact of the pandemic on
  Chester County women.
- Our community collaboration and education forums, both in-person and virtual, raise awareness and promote engagement to help women and girls rise.

Through the power of collective giving, The Fund's grantmaking in our last fiscal year touched over **16,500** community members in need. Over **13,500** identify as female.


