



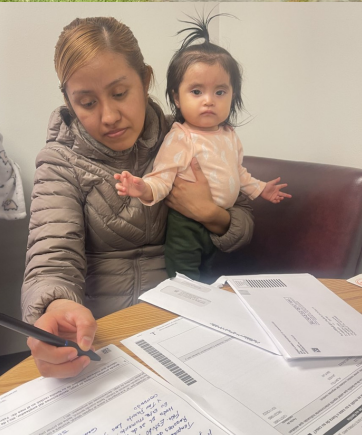

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Yasmine Mustafa

This year's dynamic guest speaker is Yasmine Mustafa, who grew up in Royersford, PA. She will unite and inspire attendees in her keynote talk about her local roots, her path to adulthood, and her tech career.

Yasmine Mustafa is fueled by a passion to leverage technology for good. She is a social entrepreneur, activist, and the founder of ROAR for Good @roarforgood, a company that creates wearable technology for personal safety. She is also the co-founder of Girl Develop It, a nonprofit organization that provides affordable technology classes to help women learn how to code in a safe, judgment-free zone. Mustafa has been recognized for her work by numerous organizations, including Forbes, CNN, and Philadelphia Magazine.

Dedicated to fostering inclusive opportunities in business and education, Yasmine draws upon her own experiences as an immigrant and woman in tech to create a platform for conversation and igniting change. In addition to ROAR, Yasmine launched the Philadelphia chapter of Girl Develop It (a non-profit providing affordable opportunities for women to learn software development) and serves on the board of Coded by Kids (a non-profit providing free tech education to inner-city youth).



KITCHEN TABLE AWARD

Loretta Perna

Loretta Perna has worked tirelessly for two decades to motivate, equip, and transition high school students to post-secondary education and adulthood. Through the Walk In kNowledge (WIN) program, Loretta provides extra support to students at Kennett High School, which enables them to perform their best academically, become more involved in their school and community, and prepare for their futures.

Through WIN, Loretta prepares these young individuals for college and provides them with the confidence and leadership skills needed to thrive. A critical component of Loretta's success is the mentorship she gives to all of the students she works with, but especially to Latina girls. Loretta builds strong, trusting relationships with the girls and their families, guiding them through the college application process and into their post-secondary education. Loretta celebrates the accomplishments of her students with a deep conviction that anything is possible with a little guidance, a lot of hard work, and a creative outlook.

The Fund for Women and Girls is thrilled to celebrate and uplift the accomplishments of Loretta Perna. She is an incredible advocate for girls and all young people in our Chester County community.
